33 AD

Early Church

Non-Romanist Churches remain committed to the Bible and reject Augustinian dogma, but are forced to worship in hiding.

The Persecuted Church

Non-conformist churches remain committed to the Bible and reject Calvin's TULIP but are persecuted by Rome & Reformed.

GLOBAL Apostasy

Augustinian doctrine of fatalistic "Predestination" and salvation being predetermined by the "sovereign choice" of God.

The "damned" were created to be damned.

The "elect" were created to be elect.

Augustine gives way to Pauline doctrine for a time.

By 1436, Bibles are being printed & distributed around the world.

Calvin revived Augustine's doctrines with the "TULIP".

Salvation by divine fiat.

Election by "decree" and not by free agency.

Jesus died only for "elect".
